Duration

1/2 day

Pre-requisite Skills

Attendees should be familiar with the operation and installation of Speed-Trap systems and with the use of the Speed-Trap models configuration.

Capabilities on completion

Attendees will understand how to:

- Plan an ABI installation
- Assess the expected size of the installation
- Install with an existing Speed-Trap installation
- Configure the system to populate profiles and behaviour records
- Design the queries needed to get value from the resulting data

It does not include the use of Speed-Trap real-time components. These are covered by another course.
